1. From The N1 towards Pietersburg from Johannesburg

- N4 Witbank Offramp (hairpin bend).
- Drive past 4 offramps (Watermeyer, Rossouw, Simon Vermoten, Hanstrijd)
- Take Donkerhoek offramp – it's a toll gate.
- Turn immediate left and drive towards T junction.
- Sign should read R104 Bronkhorstpruit
- Drive approx 5 km on the right hand side, slow down ...you will see brown tourism sign, a approx 200m on the right

2. From The Pretoria City Centre

- Take Schoeman Street towards Pretoria East
- The road becomes N4 Witbank
- Drive past 4 offramps (Watermeyer, Rossouw, Simon Vermoten, Hanstrijd)
- Take Donkerhoek offramp – it's a toll gate.
- Turn immediate left and drive towards T junction.
- Sign should read R104 Bronkhorstpruit
- Drive approx 5 km on the right hand side, slow down ...you will see brown tourism sign, a approx 200m on the right

3. From Sandton City Grayston Drive

- Travel North along the M1 towards Pretoria
- After the Buccleau Interchange the M1 now becomes the N1 North
- Keep traveling North on the N1 , take Polokwane offramp.
- N4 Witbank Offramp (hairpin bend), (just after Lynwoodroad offramp)
- Drive past 4 offramps (Watermeyer, Rossouw, Simon Vermoten, Hanstrijd)
- Take Donkerhoek offramp – it's a toll gate.
- Turn immediate left and drive towards T junction.
- Sign should read R104 Bronkhorstpruit
- Drive approx 5 km on the right hand side, slow down ...you will see brown tourism sign, a approx 200m on the right.

4. From O.R.Tambo Airport

- Travel south on R21, take R25 Bapsfontein road
- At toll gate take N4 South towards Donkerhoek (you will pass the Nan-Huan Buddihst Temple and Bronkhorspruit Town)
- Take Donkerhoek offramp and drive right (crossing the N4 highway below) – it's a toll gate.
- Drive towards T junction.
- Sign should read R104 BronkhorstpruitDrive approx 5 km on the right hand side, slow down ...you will see brown tourism sign, a approx 200m on the right.
